

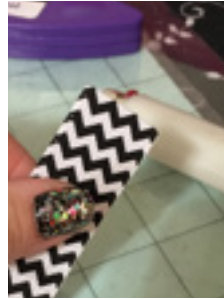
The Snapsetter

HOW TO USE THE SNAPSETTER TOOL
BY SNAPSOURCE FOR SIZE 16 SNAPS

AS SEEN IN OUR PACIFIER CLIP TUTORIAL



1. You will first determine where you want your snap.



2. You'll put the backing piece of the bottom half of your snap inside the bottom third of the snap-setter with the prongs facing up.



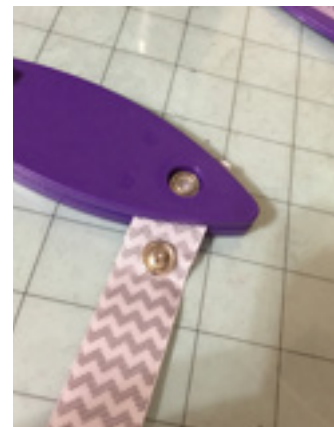
3. Place the piece of ribbon (or fabric) on top of the prongs so that the prongs begin to poke through the textile. Then place the middle piece of the snapsetter on top of the ribbon.



4. Then place the "snapping" piece of the snap inside the hole of the middle piece so it's resting on the base piece.

5. Place the top third of the snapsetter on top and tap it with a hammer a few times. The bottom half of your snap is now assembled.

6. Follow steps 1-5 using your two remaining "ring" pieces to make the top half of your snap.



7. Using the snaps, attach the ribbon around the pacifier clip (which will attach to the baby's clothing).



8. Follow steps 1-6 to make another set of snaps on the other end of your ribbon and use those snaps to attach it to the pacifier.



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
